Our uniform and equipment expectations are focused on ensuring that students are smart and well prepared for learning. We are as explicit as possible, to ensure that no money is wasted, and there are choices for all suppliers.

Notes:

- This list is intended to be very clear, to enable correct uniform purchases to be made
- Please ask if anything is unclear
- Compulsory badged items have been minimised, and are marked with a *. All other items can be purchased from a supplier of your choice including supermarkets
- Essential badged items – tie, blazer badge and PE t-shirt can be purchased from TFA reception, either with our card/contactless machine or by paying on Parent Pay

Compulsory items – Uniform		
*Blazer – black with TFA badge.	School blazer with embroidered TFA badge from 'School Uniform Direct' Or Badge can be purchased from TFA reception with blazer purchased from supermarket/other uniform suppliers	£32.50-£35.00 £4 plus cost of black blazer
*Tie	TFA striped navy tie From 'School Uniform Direct' or from TFA reception	£6.50
White buttoned shirt with collar	From supermarket or any uniform supplier Not polo-shirt style	
Black knee-length skirt	Skirt - Black Pleated Skirt – knee length Must not be A-line style or tight fitting Must be worn with either black tights or knee-length white/black socks.	



<i>or</i> black tailored trousers	<i>or</i> Trousers - Plain Black – tailored – not tight, flares, sports, combats or leggings.	
Plain black shoes	These can be trainer style, but must be completely black without any markings or logos in different colours.	
School bag	Students must bring a school bag with them everyday - big enough to hold A4 books and their equipment for the day. From supermarket or any uniform supplier	
Compulsory items – PE Kit		
*PE T-shirt	Navy with school badge. From 'School Uniform Direct' or from TFA reception	£10-12
Navy blue track bottoms or leggings	From supermarket or any uniform supplier No logos or patterns.	
PE trainers	Any sports trainer can be worn. If trainer-style shoes are worn as school shoes (as above) these can be the same if you wish.	
Optional items – Uniform		
Black V-neck jumper	Plain black with no logos or branding No zips or hoods/hoodies or cardigan style From supermarket or any uniform supplier	
*Summer Polo – grey	<i>Can be worn from Easter Holidays until October half term instead of white shirt/tie</i> Long-sleeved and short sleeved options are available From 'School Uniform Direct' Blazer must still be worn with a summer polo	£8-9.50
Black tailored shorts	<i>Can be worn from Easter Holidays until October half term instead of trousers/skirt</i> Must be knee length, tailored, not combat or sports style and must not be tight-fitting. From supermarket or any uniform supplier	
Optional items – PE Kit		
PE Shorts – plain navy	Supermarket or any uniform supplier	£5-6
*PE Rain Jacket	Navy with school logo School Uniform direct	£24-30
*PE Mid-layer training top	Navy with school logo School Uniform direct	£16.50-£21



Uniform Notes

- Student's name should be on all items
- No hats/hoods are to be worn inside – they can be brought to school during hot or cold weather but only worn outside of buildings
- Coats must be sensible styles, which protect from cold/rain in playgrounds and on journey to/from school
- No hoodies to be worn – either as coats or as replacements for school jumpers
- No items which conceal the face, e.g. face masks, snoods, handkerchiefs etc are to be worn
- If a hijab is worn, it must be plain black/navy
- For PE, if a headcovering is worn, it must be lycra for safety reasons
- Hair coverings can only be worn for religious reasons
- Jackets must not have prominent logos or branding
- Mobile phones and all other valuables are brought at student's own risk – at no stage does the school accept responsibility for them. **Please see Mobile Phone policy below.** Air pods and other headphones must not be visible around the school e.g. on corridors etc.

Essential Equipment

- **Suitable school bag – bring this to school every day**
- Pencil case with the following:
 - o Ball-point pens
 - o 15 or 30cm ruler
 - o Pencils
 - o Rubber
 - o Pencil sharpener
 - o Set square
 - o Scientific Calculator
 - o Geometry compass
