In a week of glorious sunshine at TFA, we discovered that our student attendance this year is in the top 10% nationally (above 95%) —a fantastic achievement for all. Highlights this week:

- The U16 Basketball team produced their best performance yet to secure an 82-25 win against Woodbridge to finish the league campaign unbeaten and move into the Redbridge Basketball final. - Students from years 9-13 attended our in-house careers fair, engaging with representatives from the NHS, the Royal Air Force, the Fire Brigade, City University and higher education colleges. This allowed them to gain valuable insights into their next steps and future career plans.
- It was also wonderful to see former student Muhammed return to inspire TFA students. He is now studying Law at City and working for the university in his spare time.
